

Accessibility statement

While Hotel Meudon's current owners have committed to improving accessibility to every possible area of the building during the next phases of development, the hotel is a large, historic property, built several hundred years ago and therefore, all areas are not accessible by wheelchair.

Lifts:

We currently have one lift which goes from the bridge to the restaurant (Note: It does not go to the top floor of the hotel)

Car Parking:

We have ample parking, with several spaces very close to the reception area.

Bedrooms:

Rooms 1 and 2 are accessible rooms, both containing wet rooms. Note: These rooms currently have standard width doors, and so not suitable for wheelchair access.

Self-catering cottage:

Has steps leading down to cottage and not suitable for a wheelchair

Restaurant:

The restaurant can be accessed using the lift, via the side carpark door along the bridge and then down one level in the lift. Please contact us to ask if you are unsure.



Toilets:

The family bathroom located near the sanctuary suite is accessible from the side door of the carpark or in the lift and across the bridge area.

Gardens:

Areas of the garden are uneven and it is not suitable for wheelchairs.

Beach:

The beach is not currently accessible via wheelchair as access is via the gardens.
